

FEMALE STATE TEAM COACH APPLICATIONS

Applications are now open for all Coach and Assistant Coach Positions for the 2017 Female U13 and U15 State Teams.

Coaches in conjunction with the State Technical Director and Head Coach of the BRFC/QAS NTC Women's Program will be required to select players to attend the National Youth Championships which are held in Coffs Harbour during July.

Qualifications:

- Head Coach minimum FFA/AFC 'B' Licence
 - (Must have attended an FFA Refresher Course post 2012)
- Assistant Coach minimum FFA/AFC 'C' Licence
- Must be conversant and worked in an environment of the FFA Curriculum for the past 2 years.

Required Commitment:

- Coaches will oversee players on field conduct from the initial selection process until the end of training/game/tournament.
- Coaches will be required to attend Representative Coaching and Development sessions as directed by the State Technical Director.
- Coaches will work within the guidelines set down by the State Technical Director and Football Queensland.
- Coaches will be required to attend and/or coach at specifically organised camps/sessions.
- Coaches will be required to liaise with the State Technical Director on matters concerning all technical matters, including but not limited to team-training format and trial games.
- Coaches will be required to liaise with the State and Major Events Co-Ordinator on matters concerning training times, venues etc.
- Coaches will be required to present a team-training program to the State Technical Director for all training sessions.
- Coaches will be required to travel to and from the National Youth Championships with their team on the transport provided.

Commitment Timeline:

Female Teams:

- (a) Coaches will be required to attend designated ICC 'Northern' Region rounds to identify players in relative age groups.
- (b) In addition to the Northern Identification, Coaches will also be required to attend games to select players through the PlayStation 4 National Premier Leagues Competition.
- (c) Coaches will be required to attend the April Final Selection Camp and produce a camp program for your relative age group.
- (d) Coaches will be required to work with the SEQ based squad members on a weekly basis leading up to the National Youth Championships and in addition to this Coaches may be required to work with selected players prior to the end of the calendar year.
- (e) Coaches will be required to liaise with 'Regional' Club Technical Directors in order to develop a training program for regional players selected.
- (f) Coaches will be required to prepare a Pre-National's and National's Program for their relevant team, no less than four (4) weeks prior to the National Youth Championships.
- (g) Coaches will be required to attend a Pre-Nat's Camp in Brisbane (June/July) prior to the National Youth Championships.
- (h) Coaches are required to attend the National Youth Championships in Coffs Harbour in July.

Closing Date:

Applicants are required to submit their resume along with a covering letter outlining recent coaching experience that is suitable for this position, no later than COB **Monday 29th August** to <u>craigb@footballqueensland.com.au</u>
