



STATE TEAM - COACHING APPLICATION

A vacancy exists in the U14 State Metro Team for an Assistant Coach for the 2017 National Youth Championships. Football Queensland now invites interested candidates to apply.

The successful applicant, in conjunction with the Head Coach, State Technical Director and the Skill Acquisition Head Coach will be required to select players to attend the Championships which will be held in Coffs Harbour during September.

Qualifications:

Assistant Coach minimum FFA/AFC 'C' Licence, prefer 'B' Licence

Required Commitment:

1. Coaches will oversee players on field conduct from the initial selection process until the end of training/game/tournament.
2. Coaches will be required to attend Representative Coaching and Development sessions as directed by the State Technical Director.
3. Coaches will work within the guidelines set down by the State Technical Director and Football Queensland.
4. Coaches will be required to attend and/or coach at specifically organised camps/sessions.
5. Coaches will be required to liaise with the State Technical Director / Head Coach of Skill Acquisition matters concerning all technical matters, including but not limited to team-training format and trial games.
6. Coaches will be required to liaise with appointed Football Queensland administrator on matters regarding training times, venues etc.
7. Coaches will be required to present a team-training program to the State Technical Director/ Head Coach of Skill Acquisition.
8. Coaches will be required to travel to and from the National Youth Championships with their team on the transport provided.

Commitment Timeline:

Male Teams:

- a) State Coaches (Metro) are responsible for identifying players from the weekly PlayStation 4 NPL (SEQ) Competition.
- b) Metro Coaches will be required to work with their selected 20-man squad from May through to September. The commitment to this program is two nights per week.
- c) All Coaches will be required to attend a Pre-Nat's Camp in Coffs Harbour prior to the National Youth Championships, which commence on Tuesday, 19th September and conclude on Friday, 29th September. Travel Days are Tuesday, 19th September and Saturday, 30th September.

Closing Date: Applicants are required to submit their resume along with a covering letter outlining recent coaching experience that is suitable for this position, no later than COB **Friday 17th February** to Wendya@competitionservices.com.au
