POSITION SUMMARY	<p>The purpose of this role is to help develop the next generation of Queensland Brisbane Roar and Matilda players.</p> <p>The program will have 5 contacts a week (4 trainings + 1 Game or 3 Trainings + 2 Games) and will go for approximately 42 weeks a year.</p> <p>Trainings will be afternoons between 4-8pm depending on the age group and games will require travel.</p> <p>The assistant coach will be expected to be organized and planned for every contact.</p> <p>This position is a stepping stone to a head coaching role so you will therefore be expected to be heavily involved in every aspect of the program</p> <p>Remuneration based on experience and qualification</p>
