REFEREE MATCHDAY PROTOCOL CHECKLIST

This checklist is to guide referees through the matchday protocols to be observed during Stage 3 of the Queensland Government's roadmap to easing COVID-19 restrictions.

This should be used in conjunction with Government advice and Football Queensland's latest Return to Play guidelines.

Any person showing signs and symptoms of COVID-19 must not attend clubs/venues, training sessions or matches and should seek medical advice.

Referee Matchday Protocol Checklist	
General Guidelines	 Download COVIDSafe app. If you feel unwell or display COVID-19 symptoms, stay at home and contact your appointments officer ASAP. Wash/sanitise hands regularly, including before games and at half-time and full-time. Do not share or borrow equipment (e.g. drinks bottles, clothes, whistles, hats, pens, clipboards). Observe social distancing (1.5 metres) and good hygiene practices (e.g. no spitting, cover mouth and nose with a tissue or your elbow when sneezing/coughing). Note that change rooms, referee rooms, benches and dugouts are considered the field of play, therefore occupant density requirements do not have to be met in these areas.
Before Matches	 Arrive at ground 25 minutes before KO wearing referee polo/ref shirt, shorts, socks and Kappa FQ jacket (if you have one). Clean hands at hand sanitiser stations or in bathrooms. Check in and find ground official and confirm whether referee room or designated staging area is to be used. Ask ground official to confirm whether referee room showers can be used. If required, use referee room/staging area/bathrooms to change into match shirt after assessing team/GK colours. Leave bags in referee room. Conduct 5-10 minute pre-match warm-up in line with FQ guidance.
During Matches	 Remind players to follow protocols and to drink water if spitting or coughing.



	 Return to and remain in referee room/staging area at half-time while maintaining social distancing. Only take/handle one match ball at half-time (ground official to monitor spare balls). Sanitise hands at half-time. Complete team sheets up to this point. Do not share pens or clipboards.
After Matches	 Leave field at full-time as promptly as possible. Return to referee room/staging area and cover referee wear with Kappa FQ jacket if possible. Only use showers if approved by ground official. Finalise team sheets in referee room/staging area at full-time. Do not share pens or clipboards. Leave venue in same attire or cover with jacket/tracksuit unless you have showered and changed. If referee assessment has taken place, debrief must occur offsite. Wash/clean all used kit/equipment before next use.
