

MATCH REVIEW PANEL

THURSDAY 15 AUGUST 2024

On Thursday 15 August 2024, the Football Queensland Match Review Panel (MRP) convened to consider two incidents arising from Round 21 of the FQPL 1 Men competition.

St George Willawong vs Eastern Suburbs – Loughlin Sharma (St George Willawong)

The MRP considered an incident involving Loughlin Sharma of St George Willawong on or around the 14th minute of St George Willawong's FQPL 1 Men match against Eastern Suburbs on Saturday 10 August.

In accordance with the Football Queensland Disciplinary Regulations (the **Regulations**), the MRP has the authority to consider the incident as Sharma was issued with a direct Red Card by the referee.

The MRP determined that Sharma committed the offence of '*R5 Denying an obvious goal scoring opportunity to an opponent moving towards the opponent's goal by an offence punishable by a free kick*'. The minimum sanction for the offence is one (1) match, being the Mandatory Match Suspension.

The MRP confirmed that Sharma will serve a suspension of one (1) match, being the minimum sanction for the offence.

SWQ Thunder vs Capalaba FC – Asante Attilio (Capalaba FC)

The MRP considered an incident involving Asante Attilio (Capalaba FC) on or around the 79th minute of Capalaba FC's FQPL 1 Men match against SWQ Thunder on Saturday 10 August.

In accordance with the Football Queensland Disciplinary Regulations (the **Regulations**), the MRP has the authority to consider the incident as Attilio was issued with a direct Red Card by the referee.

The MRP determined that Attilio committed the offence of '*R1 02-01 Attempting to gain possession of the ball using excessive force*'. The minimum sanction for the offence is two (2) matches, being the Mandatory Match Suspension plus one additional fixture.

Being Attilio's second direct red card of the season, pursuant to the Regulations an additional match suspension is added on to any sanction given. The MRP confirmed that Attilio will serve a suspension of three (3) matches, being the minimum sanction for the offence plus an additional match for a second direct red card of the season.
