**RULES OF
COMPETITION**

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1. SCOPE AND OBJECTIVES

- (a) The Rules of Competition (RoC) are set by Football Queensland (FQ) as the administrator of the Pacific Junior Championships and supplement the broader IFAB Laws of the Game. They are intended to provide clarity as to the playing format for the Pacific Junior Championships fixtures as well as the matchday procedures and disciplinary processes, if required and to be read and delivered supplementary and in accordance with the Laws of the Game as determined by IFAB.
- (b) These Regulations are to be read in conjunction with the relevant FQ Regulations, Policies and By Laws and FA's Statutes and Regulations (including National Disciplinary Regulations, National Registration Regulations and FQ Disciplinary Regulations). In the event of an omission or inconsistency between these regulations and other FQ policies, Football Queensland will determine and rule on the interpretation.

2. COMPETITION STRUCTURE

2.1 Competition Administrator

- (a) Football Queensland (FQ) serves as the Competition Administrator for the Pacific Junior Championships. FQ will appoint an operations contact at the venue for the entire duration of the tournament. FQ will also prepare the schedule and fixture list for all matches. Each team's officials are responsible for their own game day operations.
- (b) The Competition Administrator has the authority to suspend, reprimand, caution, or otherwise penalize any players, teams, or officials who are deemed to have breached the rules of the game and/or tournament, or whose actions have brought the game into disrepute.
- (c) Football Queensland reserves the right to interpret the Rules of Competitions (RoC) in the event of any dispute. Pacific Junior Championships Managers and Coaches are advised to seek clarification from FQ if they have any doubts regarding the meaning, interpretation, or application of the RoC. Football Queensland retains the right to amend or alter the Rules of Competition at its absolute discretion as needed.

2.2 Eligibility of Teams

- (a) The Pacific Junior Championships will be divided into 1 competition for each age group and conducted in the following groups:

- (b) Teams are limited to a maximum of fourteen (14) players and three (3) coaching staff.
(Unless cleared by FQ)
- (c) Teams are required to submit Team Sheets 20 minutes prior to each match.

2.3 Squadi Team Sheets

Both the home and away teams are expected to have submitted their Squadi Team Sheet with player selections and Team Officials, 20 minutes prior to the scheduled fixture.

Any required changes to the player selections after this deadline must be raised with the Match Official and a Squadi incident report detailing relevant changes must be submitted by the manager/club prior to kick off and the Match Official on entering the results of a game.

Squadi Teams Sheets must be submitted with the following information:

- a) All players and officials participating in the match are listed on the Squadi Team Sheet with an identifiable ID Photo.
- b) All players are listed with the correct jersey number.
- c) No more than the permitted number of players are listed on the Squadi Team Sheet.

If clubs believe information (results, goal scorers and/or cards) have been recorded incorrectly in Squadi, clubs are encouraged to seek the competition operational team in the Event Operational Room.

No Club Official or Match Official has the power to refuse to allow an opposition player to take the field for any reason. If there are any discrepancies between the Squadi Team Sheet and the players and team officials participating in the match the Match Official must include this in an incident report.

Any breaches the submission of Squadi Team Sheets will be subject to fines and penalties.

2.4 Eligibility of Players

- (a) Players participating in the Pacific Junior Championships fixtures must be registered using Squadi for the tournament to ensure appropriate insurance coverage.
- (b) All players must be age-appropriate for each age group, for clarity please see the table below;

- (c) Younger or older players may be permitted to play in these age groups in exceptional circumstances only through application to Football Queensland ([click here to access the age dispensation form](#)). Football Queensland reserves the right to approve or deny applications and rescind them at any time throughout the tournament.

2.5 Tournament & Playing Format

- All matches will be played at **Maroochydore Football Club**, as per the fixture list prepared by Football Queensland.
- FQ will provide all participating teams with the fixture list prior to the Pacific Junior Championships.
- All Fixtures will be played as per the FIFA Laws of the Game, as outlined in the following Competition Format.
- The only exception to these regulations is the offside rule exclusive for the U12/13 Girls and U13 Boys, which will **APPLY** to their fixtures. Teams are, however, strongly encouraged to play within the spirit of the game and ensure players are occupying inside positions.

2.6 Competition Format

- The Pacific Junior Championships shall consist of:
 - Group Stage: All teams playing against each other within their designated groups
 - Finals Stage: Consisting of knockout matches outlined in the table below
- The determination as to the teams participating in the relevant Finals Stage matches defined above will be based on the rankings of each team on the competition ladder.
- Penalty shootout will take place if Playoffs/Final ends in a draw. Three (3) Penalty are allowed for each team.

2.7 Competition Points

- (a) The following points will be awarded for all Pacific Junior Championships fixtures during the Group Stage of the competitions:

Result	Points Accumulated
Win	3 Points
Draw	1 Point
Loss	0 Points

Forfeit Received	3 Points and a 3-0 Winning Result

2.8 Competitions Placings

- (a) Football Queensland will use the following criteria when determining the ranking of Teams within each Competition:
- i. Highest number of points accumulated during the Group Stage.
 - ii. If two (2) or more Teams are equal on points accumulated, the following criteria will be applied, in order, until one (1) of the Clubs can be determined as the higher ranked:
 - a. Highest Goal Difference
 - b. Highest Goals For
 - c. Highest number of points accumulated in the Group Stage Matches between the Teams concerned (head-to-head)
 - d. Highest number of goals scored in the Group Stage Matches between the Teams concerned (head-to-head)
 - e. Lowest number of red cards accumulated; and
 - f. Toss of a coin in the event of a tie of two (2) teams or drawing of lots in the event of a tie of three (3) or more teams.

2.9 Duration of Matches

(a) The duration of matches for each age group is outlined in the table below.

- (b) There will be no injury/additional time added to any matches during the tournament.
- (c) There will be no extra time or penalties in matches during the Group Stage of the competitions in the event of a draw at the conclusion of normal time.
- (d) In the event of a draw at the conclusion of normal time for Elimination Finals, Playoffs, Quarter Finals, Semi Finals and Finals Stage matches, alternate kicks from the penalty mark shall be taken to determine the winner, in accordance with the procedures described in the Laws of the Game. For clarification, no extra time will be played in the event of a draw at the end of normal time.

2.10 Return Substitutions (Interchange)

- (a) In all Pacific Junior Championships fixtures, unlimited Return Substitutions (Interchange) are permitted. A player who has been substituted may return to the field for another player.
- (b) Referees are to be notified before changes are made. Substitutions happen at dead-ball moments, breaks, or unless of injury and fatigue.
- (c) Substitutions will be able to be made throughout the first 15 minutes of each half and at half-time, but not within the last 5 minutes of either half unless required due to injuries.

3. DISCIPLINARY

3.1 Red Cards/Expulsions

- (a) If a red card or send off is issued throughout the Pacific Junior Championships, the sent off player may not play any further part in that fixture but may be replaced by another player.
- (b) Any Player sent from the field during a match, may only be permitted to play the next match in accordance with the sanctions outlined in the following table:

- (c) A disciplinary committee will be formed by Football Queensland to oversee and administer all disciplinary matters relating (including red card suspensions) to the Pacific Junior Championships.

- (d) The Football Queensland Disciplinary Committee will attend the Pacific Junior Championships and will address all matters in an urgent manner due to the structure of the tournament.
- (e) All disciplinary sanctions will be by the Football Queensland Disciplinary Committee.
- (f) Any match suspension/s are to be served in the team's next Pacific Junior Championships match/es. The suspended player/team official is ineligible to participate until the suspension has been served in full.
- (g) The Sin Bin rule will not apply to fixtures in the Pacific Junior Championships

3.2 Appeals

- (a) A player or team official cannot appeal against a mandatory match suspension, except in the case of alleged mistaken identity.
- (b) All appeals will be lodged with and handled by the Football Queensland Disciplinary Committee, who will attend the tournament.
- (c) There will be no appeal fee payable by the teams.

3.3 Misconduct

- (a) All instances of players, spectators, officials, or teams conducting themselves in a manner contravening the rules of the competition or behaving in an unseemly manner likely to bring the game into disrepute, shall be immediately investigated by Football Queensland for consideration and subsequent action.

3.4 Match Officials

- (a) Football Queensland will be responsible for the allocation of a match official to each match throughout the tournament.
- (b) No payments are to be made to the match officials throughout the course of the tournament. Football Queensland will coordinate any referee payments if required.
- (c) In the event of referee injury or misadventure, FQ will determine whether the fixture is abandoned, delayed, or postponed. Whichever is most applicable.

4. FOOTBALL AND MATCH DAY OPERATIONS

4.1 Technical Area & Ground Officials

- (a) Football Queensland staff will be available throughout the day if issues arise.
- (b) For all matches played during the tournament, a maximum of eight (8) people are permitted to occupy the technical area for each team. This includes the five (5) substitutes and up to three (3) registered team officials.
- (c) Injured players are not to occupy the technical area, only players & team officials are permitted.
- (d) Suspended players or officials cannot occupy the technical area.
- (e) All substitutes must be seated in the technical area. Substitutes are permitted to warm up outside the technical area, provided they are wearing bibs or an alternative coloured uniform to both team strips. Balls are not to be used in warm-ups throughout the duration of the match.
- (f) Under the FIFA Laws of the Game, all occupants of the technical area who are behaving in an irresponsible manner may be expelled from the technical area by the match officials and/or referee coaches. The match will not commence until such time as the match officials deem that the individual is an adequate distance from the field of play.

4.2 Medical

- (a) Concussion Management: Any player suspected of having a concussion will require medical clearance from a doctor. The team official must present the doctor's certificate to our Competition Management Team before the player is allowed to return to play.

4.3 Match Balls

- (a) Football Queensland is responsible for providing three (3) match balls for each field in operation. The match officials will remain in charge of these match balls throughout each day.
- (b) Size 4 match balls will be used for all U11, U12 and U13 games.

4.4 Strip Colours

- (a) All teams competing in the Pacific Junior Championships are required to confirm their strip colours to Football Queensland prior to the tournament commencing.
- (b) Teams may not vary from their nominated strip colours. Failure to comply with nominated strip colours may result in the guilty team being penalised and the result being recorded as a 3-0 in favor of the opposing team. The referee and tournament directors are asked to rule on any misinterpretation or strip clash and seek an alternate option (strip change).

4.5 Photography of Players

- (a) By participating and attending the Pacific Junior Championships, participants and spectators give permission for their images to be used by Football Queensland and approved photography personnel on media platforms to report on the event and promote future events.

4.6 Wet/Adverse Weather Procedure

- (a) In the event of wet or adverse weather, FQ representatives along with the appointed match official will determine in their sole and absolute discretion whether the match is to take place.

4.7 Abandoned Matches

- (a) In the event of a match being abandoned before full-time due to adverse weather or any other cause which neither team nor the match officials have control, the match result at the time of the abandonment will be declared the final result.
- (b) Any team who is found to be responsible, either directly or indirectly, for the abandonment or forfeit of a fixture may be subject to sanctions. The match will be recorded as a 3-0 win in favor of the opposing team, unless the score at the time of abandonment was of a greater margin in favor of the opposing team, and the points will be awarded to the opposing team.

5. Trophies & Medals

- (a) All medals and trophies will be presented after the Grand Final in each competition.
- (b) Football Queensland will present the following medals and trophies at the conclusion of the tournament:
 - Champions: 17x gold medals and 1x gold trophy
 - Runners Up: 17x silver medals

- 3rd place: 17x bronze medals
- Match Official: U11 and U12 Finals – 1x Bronze Coin Medal; U12/13 and U13 Finals – 3x Bronze Coin Medal

(c) Medal Ceremony will be presented at the Maroochydore Football Club – Fields 5A & 5B as per schedule below:

- 2:00 pm to 3:00 pm

(d) Football Queensland will present the following in each Competition:
