

## MATCH REVIEW PANEL

### THURSDAY 29 MAY 2025

On Thursday 29 May 2025, the Football Queensland Match Review Panel (MRP) convened to consider two incidents arising from Round 11 of the FQPL 1 Men competition.

#### **FQPL 1 Men: Ipswich FC vs Rochedale Rovers – Harry Talbot (Rochedale Rovers)**

The MRP considered an incident involving Harry Talbot on or around the 30<sup>th</sup> minute of Rochedale Rovers' FQPL 1 Men fixture against Ipswich FC on Saturday 24 May 2025.

In accordance with the Football Queensland Disciplinary Regulations (the **Regulations**), the MRP has the authority to consider the incident as Talbot was issued with a direct Red Card by the referee.

The MRP determined that Talbot committed the offence of '*R1 01-01 Serious foul play tackle*'. The minimum sanction for the offence is one (1) match, being the Mandatory Match Suspension.

The MRP confirmed that Talbot will serve a suspension of one (1) match, being the minimum sanction available for the offence.

#### **FQPL 1 Men: Magic United vs Capalaba FC – Zorro Skilton (Magic United)**

The MRP considered an multiple incidents involving Zorro Skilton on or around the 74<sup>th</sup> minute, and at full time of Magic United's FQPL 1 Men fixture against Capalaba FC on Saturday 24 May 2025.

In accordance with the Football Queensland Disciplinary Regulations (the **Regulations**), the MRP has the authority to consider the incident as Skilton was issued with a direct Red Card by the referee.

The MRP determined that Skilton committed multiple offences, being '*R8 04-01 Use offensive, insulting or abusive language or gestures towards a Match Official*', '*Table E 03-01 Unsportsmanlike or unprofessional behaviour*' and '*R8 01-01 Fail to abide by or comply with a direction of a Match Official*'. The minimum sanction for these offences is six (6) matches, being the Mandatory Match Suspension plus five additional fixtures.

The MRP confirmed that Skilton will serve a suspension of six (6) matches. The MRP would like to remind all participants that approaching Match Officials after a match to dispute a decision will not be tolerated at any time. Section 10.7.d of the Regulations clearly outlines the expectations pertaining to the conduct of a Participant who has been issued with a Red Card, any breaches of these Regulations will be dealt with accordingly by the MRP.
