As the Finals Series draws nearer, clubs are reminded of their obligation to ensure the behaviour of all club members, including players, coaches and spectators, aligns with the [Football Australia National Code of Conduct and Ethics](#) and the [Football Australia Spectator Code of Behaviour](#).

As outlined in Football Queensland's [Three Strike Policy](#) and under the State and National Disciplinary Regulations and Code of Conduct, a club is responsible, and liable, for the conduct and behaviour of its supporters, whether they are playing a fixture at home or at an away facility.

Clubs are also reminded of the [Roles and Responsibilities of Ground Officials](#), who play an important role in helping to ensure FQ competitions are run in a safe and secure environment in accordance with Football Queensland and Football Australia Regulations.

We appreciate the support of clubs in ensuring all participants can enjoy a safe and positive football environment, and wish you all the best of luck for the remainder of the season.
