



MATCH REVIEW PANEL

THURSDAY 26 FEBRUARY 2026

On Thursday 26 February 2026, the Football Queensland Match Review Panel (MRP) convened to consider four incidents arising from the NPL Women, NPL Men and FQPL 1 Men competitions.

NPL Women: Souths Strikers vs Gold Coast United – Sari Goodall (Souths Strikers)

The MRP considered an incident involving Sari Goodall of Souths Strikers on or around the 54th minute of Souths Strikers' NPL Women fixture against Gold Coast United on Sunday 22 February 2026.

In accordance with the Football Queensland Disciplinary Regulations (the **Regulations**), the MRP has the authority to consider the incident as Goodall was issued with a direct Red Card by the referee.

The MRP determined that Goodall committed the offence of '*R5 Denying an obvious goal scoring opportunity to an opponent moving towards the opponent's goal by an offence punishable by a free kick*'. The minimum sanction for the offence is one (1) match, being the Mandatory Match Suspension.

The MRP confirmed that Goodall will serve a suspension of one (1) match, being the minimum sanction available for the offence.

NPL Men: Peninsula Power vs Eastern Suburbs – Matt Mundy (Peninsula Power)

The MRP considered an incident involving Matt Mundy of Peninsula Power on or around the 16th minute of Peninsula Power's NPL Men fixture against Eastern Suburbs on Saturday 21 February 2026.

In accordance with the Football Queensland Disciplinary Regulations (the **Regulations**), the MRP has the authority to consider the incident as Mundy was issued with a direct Red Card by the referee.

The MRP determined that Mundy committed the offence of '*R1 02-01 Attempting to gain possession of the ball using excessive force*'. The minimum sanction for the offence is two (2) matches, being the Mandatory Match Suspension plus one additional fixture.

The MRP confirmed that Mundy will serve a suspension of two (2) matches, being the minimum sanction available for the offence.

FQPL 1 Men: Brisbane Strikers vs North Star – Ben Winlaw (North Star)

The MRP considered an incident involving Ben Winlaw of North Star on or around the 57th minute of North Star's FQPL 1 Men fixture against Brisbane Strikers on Saturday 21 February 2026.

In accordance with the Football Queensland Disciplinary Regulations (the **Regulations**), the MRP has the authority to consider the incident as Winlaw was issued with a direct Red Card by the referee.

The MRP determined that Winlaw committed the offence of '*R8 07-01 Use offensive, insulting or abusive language and/or gestures towards a Match Official*'. The minimum sanction for the offence is four (4) matches, being the Mandatory Match Suspension plus three additional fixtures.

The MRP confirmed that Winlaw will serve a suspension of four (4) matches, being the minimum sanction available for the offence.

FQPL 1 Men: Brisbane Strikers vs North Star – Kyren Walters (North Star)

The MRP considered an incident involving Kyren Walters of North Star on or around the 2nd minute of second half stoppage time of North Star's FQPL 1 Men fixture against Brisbane Strikers on Saturday 21 February 2026.

In accordance with the Football Queensland Disciplinary Regulations (the **Regulations**), the MRP has the authority to consider the incident as Walters was issued with a direct Red Card by the referee.

The MRP determined that Walters committed the offence of '*R1 01-01 Serious foul play tackle*'. The minimum sanction for the offence is one (1) match, being the Mandatory Match Suspension.

The MRP confirmed that Walters will serve a suspension of one (1) match, being the minimum sanction available for the offence.
