

MATCH REVIEW PANEL

THURSDAY 19 MARCH 2026

On Thursday 19 March 2026, the Football Queensland Match Review Panel (MRP) convened to consider multiple incidents arising from the FQPL 1 Men & NPL Women competitions.

FQPL 1 Men: St George Willawong vs Holland Park Hawks (Liam O'bryan)

The MRP considered an incident involving Liam O'bryan of Holland Park Hawks on or around the 4th minute of second half stoppage time of Holland Park Hawks' FQPL 1 Men fixture against St George Willawong on Sunday 15 March 2026.

In accordance with the Football Queensland Disciplinary Regulations (the **Regulations**), the MRP has the authority to consider the incident as O'bryan was issued with a direct Red Card by the referee.

The MRP determined that O'bryan committed the offence of 'R2 01-01 Excessive conduct when the ball is not in play or playing distance'. The minimum sanction for the offences is two (2) matches, being the Mandatory Match Suspension plus one additional fixture.

The MRP confirmed that O'bryan will serve a suspension of two (2) matches, being the minimum sanction available for the offence.

NPL Women: Capalaba FC vs Souths Strikers – Sari Goodall (Souths Strikers)

The MRP considered an incident involving Sari Goodall of Souths Strikers on or around the 64th minute of Souths Strikers' NPL Women fixture against Capalaba FC on Saturday 14 March 2026.

In accordance with the Football Queensland Disciplinary Regulations (the **Regulations**), the MRP has the authority to consider the incident as Goodall was issued with a direct Red Card by the referee.

The MRP determined that Goodall committed the offence of 'R5 Denying an obvious goal scoring opportunity to an opponent moving towards the opponent's goal by an offence punishable by a free kick'. The minimum sanction for the offence is one (1) match, being the Mandatory Match Suspension.

In addition, the incident is Goodall's second direct red card of the season which in accordance with the Regulations results in an additional suspension of one (1) fixture on top of the sanction issued for the relevant offence code.

The MRP confirmed that Goodall will serve a suspension of two (2) matches, being the minimum sanction available for the offence as a second direct red card of the season.

The MRP considered an incident involving Osman Fofanah of Caboolture Sports FC on or around the 21st minute of Caboolture Sports FC's FQPL 1 Men fixture against Brisbane Strikers on Sunday 15 March 2026.

In accordance with the Football Queensland Disciplinary Regulations (the **Regulations**), the MRP has the authority to consider the incident as Fofanah was issued with a direct Red Card by the referee.

The MRP determined that Fofanah committed the offence of '*R2 01-01 Excessive conduct when the ball is not in play or playing distance*'. The minimum sanction for the offences is two (2) matches, being the Mandatory Match Suspension plus one additional fixture.

Pursuant to the Regulations Section 19.5, the direct Red Card will be upheld despite the abandonment of the fixture on or around the 35th minute.

The MRP confirmed that Fofanah will serve a suspension of two (2) matches, being the minimum sanction available for the offence.
