



## MATCH REVIEW PANEL

### THURSDAY 26 MARCH 2026

On Thursday 26 March 2026, the Football Queensland Match Review Panel (MRP) convened to consider multiple incidents arising from the FQPL 1 Men & NPL Women competitions.

#### **NPL Women: Lions FC vs Capalaba FC – Demi Robins (Capalaba FC)**

The MRP considered an incident involving Demi Robins of Capalaba FC on or around the 62<sup>nd</sup> minute of Capalaba FC's NPL Women fixture against Lions FC on Saturday 21 March 2026.

In accordance with the Football Queensland Disciplinary Regulations (the **Regulations**), the MRP has the authority to consider the incident as Robins was issued with a direct Red Card by the referee.

The MRP determined that the Match Officials made an Obvious Error in the application of the laws of the game in issuing a red card to Robins for this incident. As such, in accordance with the Regulations the MRP has confirmed that the red card issued to Robins will be rescinded.

The MRP confirmed that Robins will not serve a Mandatory Match Suspension, and is free to participate in this weekend's fixtures.

#### **FQPL 1 Men: North Star vs St George Willawong – Arthur Gbayor (St George Willawong)**

The MRP considered an incident involving Arthur Gbayor of St George Willawong on or around the 80<sup>th</sup> minute of St George Willawong's FQPL 1 Men fixture against North Star on Friday 20 March 2026.

In accordance with the Football Queensland Disciplinary Regulations (the **Regulations**), the MRP has the authority to consider the incident as Gbayor was issued with a direct Red Card by the referee.

The MRP determined that Gbayor committed the offence of '*R2 02-01 Violent conduct when the ball is not in play or playing distance*'. The minimum sanction for the offences is five (5) matches, being the Mandatory Match Suspension plus four additional fixtures.

The MRP confirmed that Gbayor will serve a suspension of five (5) matches, being the minimum sanction available for the offence.

#### **NPL Women: FQ Academy QAS vs Eastern Suburbs – Tegan Riding (Eastern Suburbs)**

The MRP considered an incident involving Tegan Riding of Eastern Suburbs on or around the 25<sup>th</sup> minute of Eastern Suburbs' NPL Women fixture against FQ Academy QAS on Saturday 21 March 2026.

In accordance with the Football Queensland Disciplinary Regulations (the **Regulations**), the MRP has the authority to consider the incident as Riding was issued with a direct Red Card by the referee.

The MRP determined that Riding committed the offence of 'R2 01-01 Excessive conduct when the ball is not in play or playing distance'. The minimum sanction for the offences is two (2) matches, being the Mandatory Match Suspension plus one additional fixture.

The MRP confirmed that Riding will serve a suspension of two (2) matches, being the minimum sanction available for the offence.

### **FQPL 1 Men: Caboolture Sports FC vs Logan Lightning – Johnathan Caspanello (Logan Lightning)**

The MRP considered an incident involving Johnathan Caspanello of Logan Lightning on or around the 49<sup>th</sup> minute of Logan Lightning's FQPL 1 Men fixture against Caboolture Sports FC on Saturday 21 March 2026.

In accordance with the Football Queensland Disciplinary Regulations (the **Regulations**), the MRP has the authority to consider the incident as Caspanello was issued with a direct Red Card by the referee.

The MRP determined that Caspanello committed the offence of 'R4 Denying the opposing team a goal or an obvious goal-scoring opportunity by deliberately handling the ball (except a goalkeeper within their penalty area)'. The minimum sanction for the offence is one (1) match, being the Mandatory Match Suspension.

The MRP confirmed that Caspanello will serve a suspension of one (1) match, being the minimum sanction available for the offence.
