

MATCH REVIEW PANEL

THURSDAY 16 APRIL 2026

On Thursday 16 April 2026, the Football Queensland Match Review Panel (MRP) convened to consider three incidents arising from the NPL Men competition.

NPL Men: Wynnum Wolves vs Lions FC – Russell Parker (Wynnum Wolves)

The MRP considered an incident involving Russell Parker of Wynnum Wolves on or around the 10th minute of Wynnum Wolves' NPL Men fixture against Lions FC on Friday 10 April 2026.

In accordance with the Football Queensland Disciplinary Regulations (the **Regulations**), the MRP has the authority to consider the incident as Parker was issued with a direct Red Card by the referee.

The MRP determined that Parker committed the offence of '*R4 Denying the opposing team a goal or an obvious goal-scoring opportunity by deliberately handling the ball (except a goalkeeper within their penalty area)*'. The minimum sanction for the offence is one (1) match, being the Mandatory Match Suspension.

The MRP confirmed that Parker will serve a suspension of one (1) match, being the minimum sanction available for the offence.

NPL Men: Brisbane Roar B vs Peninsula Power – Joshua Woolley (Peninsula Power)

The MRP considered an incident involving Joshua Woolley of Peninsula Power on or around the 84th minute of Peninsula Power's NPL Men fixture against Brisbane Roar B on Sunday 12 April 2026.

In accordance with the Football Queensland Disciplinary Regulations (the **Regulations**), the MRP has the authority to consider the incident as Woolley was issued with a Red Card by the referee.

The MRP determined that Woolley committed two offences, being '*R7 Second Caution & R8 06-01 Use offensive, insulting or abusive language and/or gestures towards a Match Official (isolated incident)*'. The minimum sanction for the two offences is four (4) matches, being the Mandatory Match Suspension plus three (3) additional fixtures.

The MRP confirmed that Woolley will serve a suspension of four (4) matches, being the minimum sanction available for the two offences. The MRP further reminds all participants of its zero tolerance approach towards insulting or abusive language towards Match Officials at any time.

NPL Men: Brisbane Roar B vs Peninsula Power – Andrew Bernal (Brisbane Roar B)

The MRP considered an incident involving Andrew Bernal of Brisbane Roar B on or around the 79th minute of Brisbane Roar B's NPL Men fixture against Peninsula Power on Sunday 12 April 2026.

In accordance with the Football Queensland Disciplinary Regulations (the **Regulations**), the MRP has the authority to consider the incident as Bernal was issued with a direct Red Card by the referee.

The MRP determined that Bernal committed the offence of '07-01 *Delaying the restart of play by the opposing team (e.g. holding onto the ball, kicking the ball away, obstructing the movement of a Player)*' from Table C of the Regulations Tables of Offences. The minimum sanction for the offence is one (1) match, being the Mandatory Match Suspension.

The MRP confirmed that Bernal will serve a suspension of one (1) match, being the minimum sanction available for the offence.
